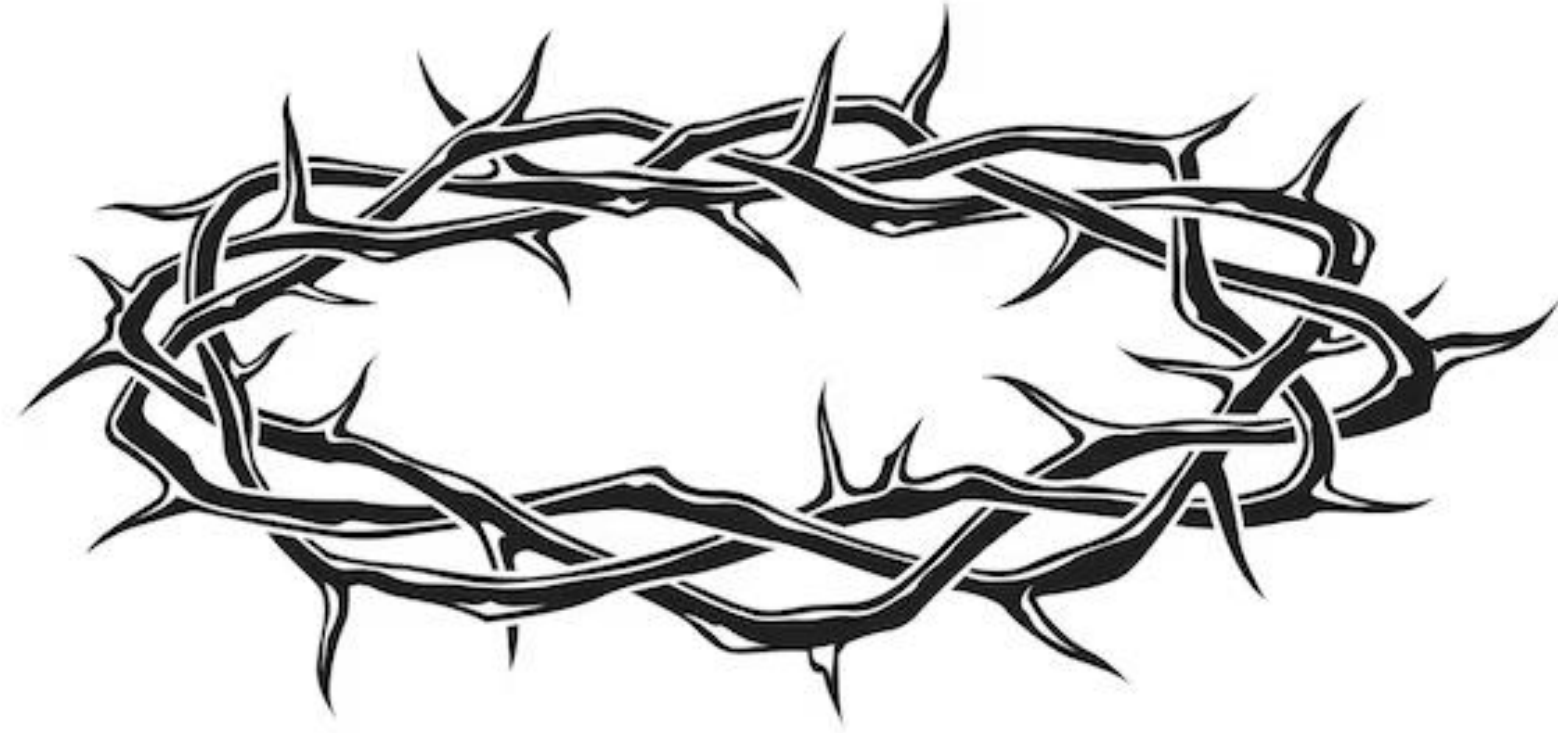

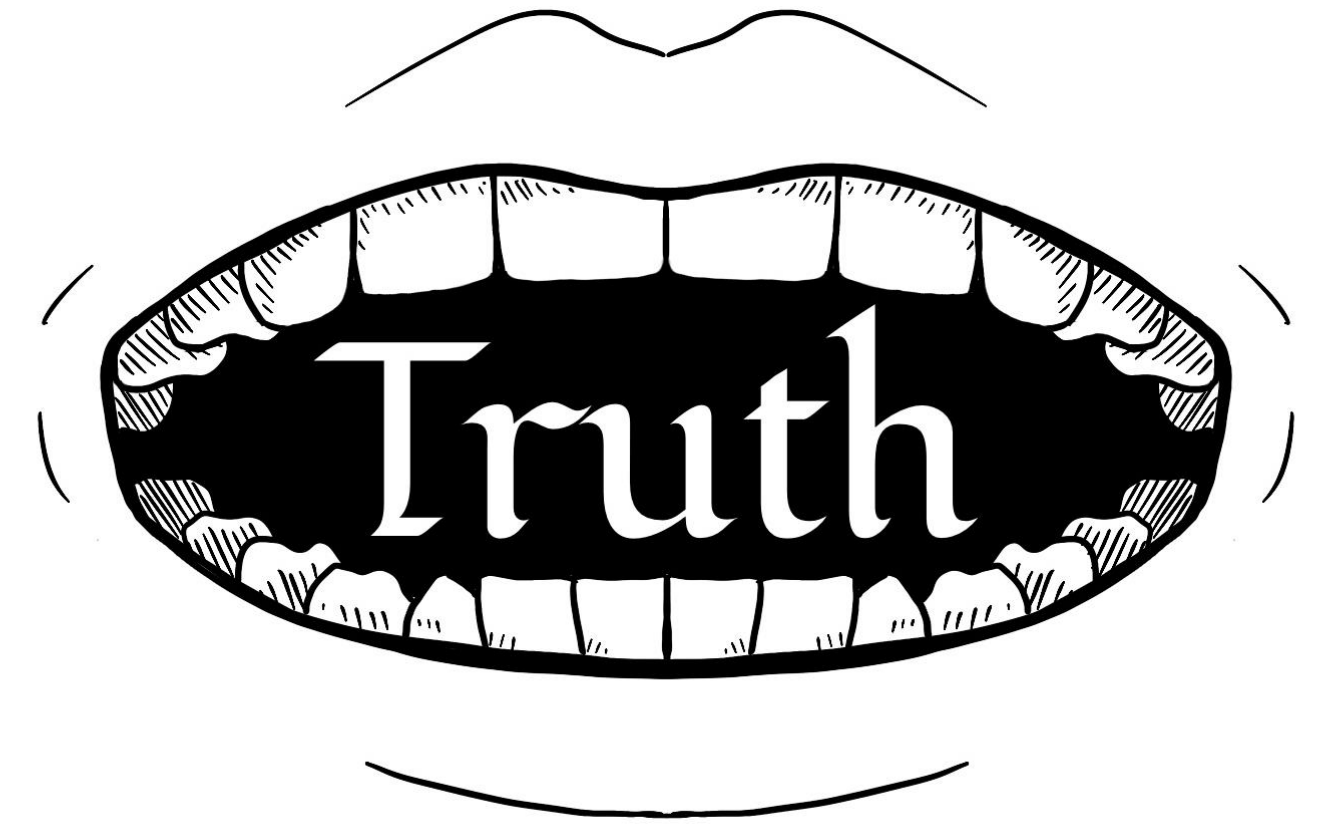

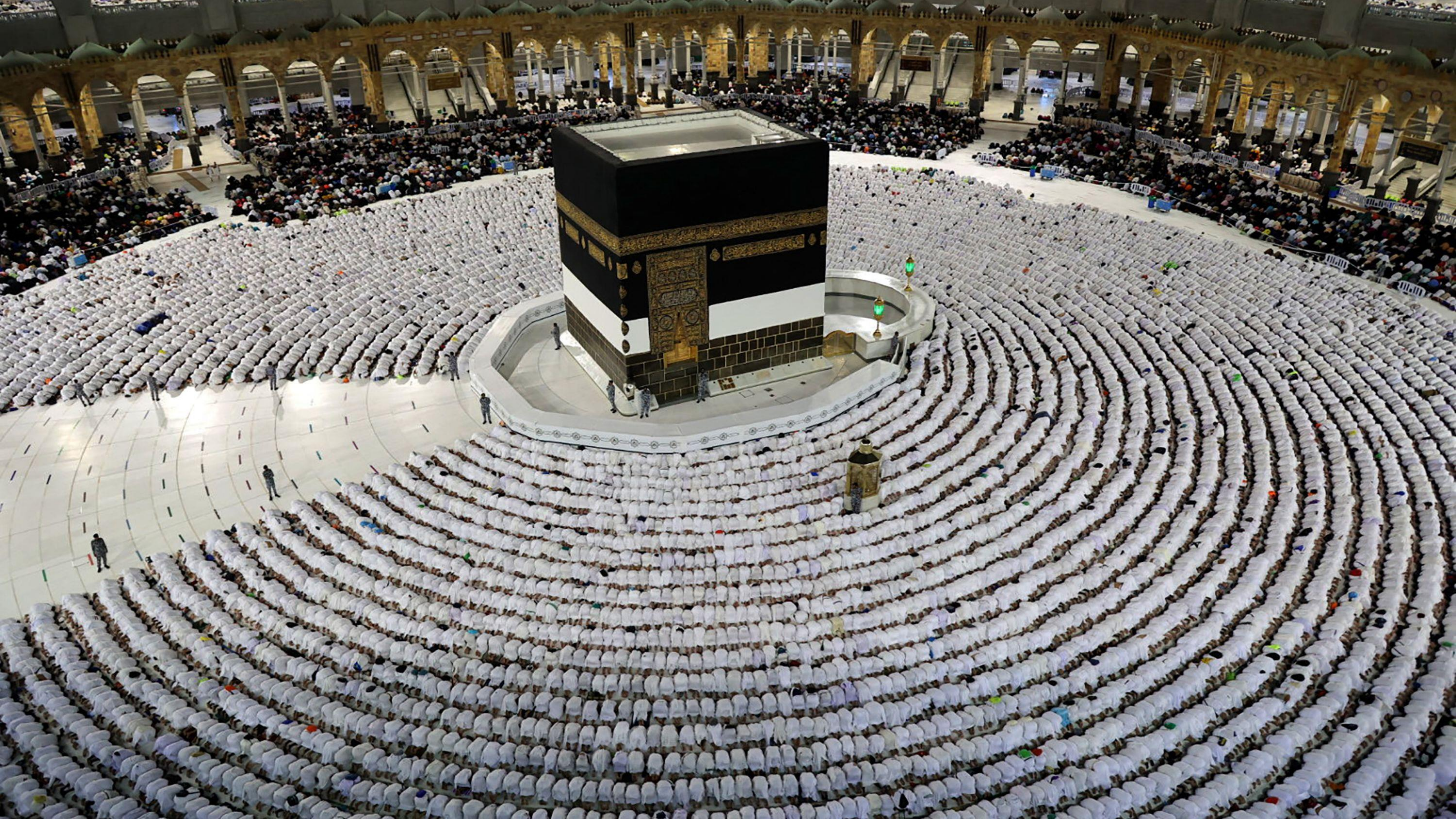

10 And he sent, and beheaded John in the prison.
11 And his head was brought in a charger, and given to the damsel; and she brought it to her mother.
12 And his disciples came, and took up the body, and buried it, and went and told Jesus.

Jesus Feeds 5,000

Mark 6:32-44; Luke 9:12-17; John 6:1-13

13 When Jesus heard of it, he departed thence by ship into a desert place apart; and when the people had heard thereof, they followed him on foot out of the cities.
14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.
15 And when it was evening, his disciples came to him, saying, This is a desert place, and the time is now past; send the multitude away, that they may go into the villages, and buy themselves victuals.
16 But Jesus said unto them, They need not depart; give ye them to eat.
17 And they say unto him, We have here but five loaves, and two fishes.
18 He said, Bring them hither to me.
19 And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake, and gave the loaves to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.
20 And they did all eat, and were filled; and they took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full.
21 And they that had eaten were about five thousand men, beside women and children.

22 And when he had sent the multitude away, he went up into a mountain apart; and when the evening was come, he was there alone.
23 But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves for the wind was contrary.
24 And in the fourth watch of the night went unto them, walking on the sea.
25 And when the disciples saw him on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out in fear.
26 But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer, it is I, Jesus who am here.
27 And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water.
28 And he said, Come. And when Peter came down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.
29 But when he saw the wind, he was afraid, and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.
30 And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?
31 And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased.
32 Then they that were in the ship worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.

CHAPTER 15 Debate over Tradition

Mark 7:1-13

13 Then came to Jesus scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying,
2 Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread.
3 But he answered and said unto them, do ye also transgress the commandment of God by your tradition?

4 And honour not his father or his mother, as shall be free. Thus have ye made the commandment of God of none effect by your tradition.
7 Ye hypocrites, well did Isaiah prophesy of you, saying,
8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.
9 But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.
10 And he called the multitude, and said unto them, Hear, and understand.
11 Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man.
12 Then came his disciples, and said unto him, Knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying?
13 But he answered and said, Every plant, which my heavenly Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up.

14 Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch.
15 Then answered Peter and said unto him, Declare unto us this parable.
16 And Jesus said, Are ye also yet without understanding?
17 Do not ye yet understand, that whatsoever entereth in at the mouth goeth into the belly, and is cast out into the draught?
18 But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man.
19 For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, envies, false witness, blasphemies:
20 These are the things which defile a man; but to eat with unwashed hands defileth not a man.

Jesus Heals the Gentle Woman's Daughter

Mark 7:24-30

21 Then Jesus went thence, and departed into the coasts of Tyre and Sidon.
22 And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil.
23 But he answered her not a word. And his disciples came and besought him, saying, Send her away; for she crieth after us.
24 But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

27 And she said, Truth, Lord; yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table.
28 Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.

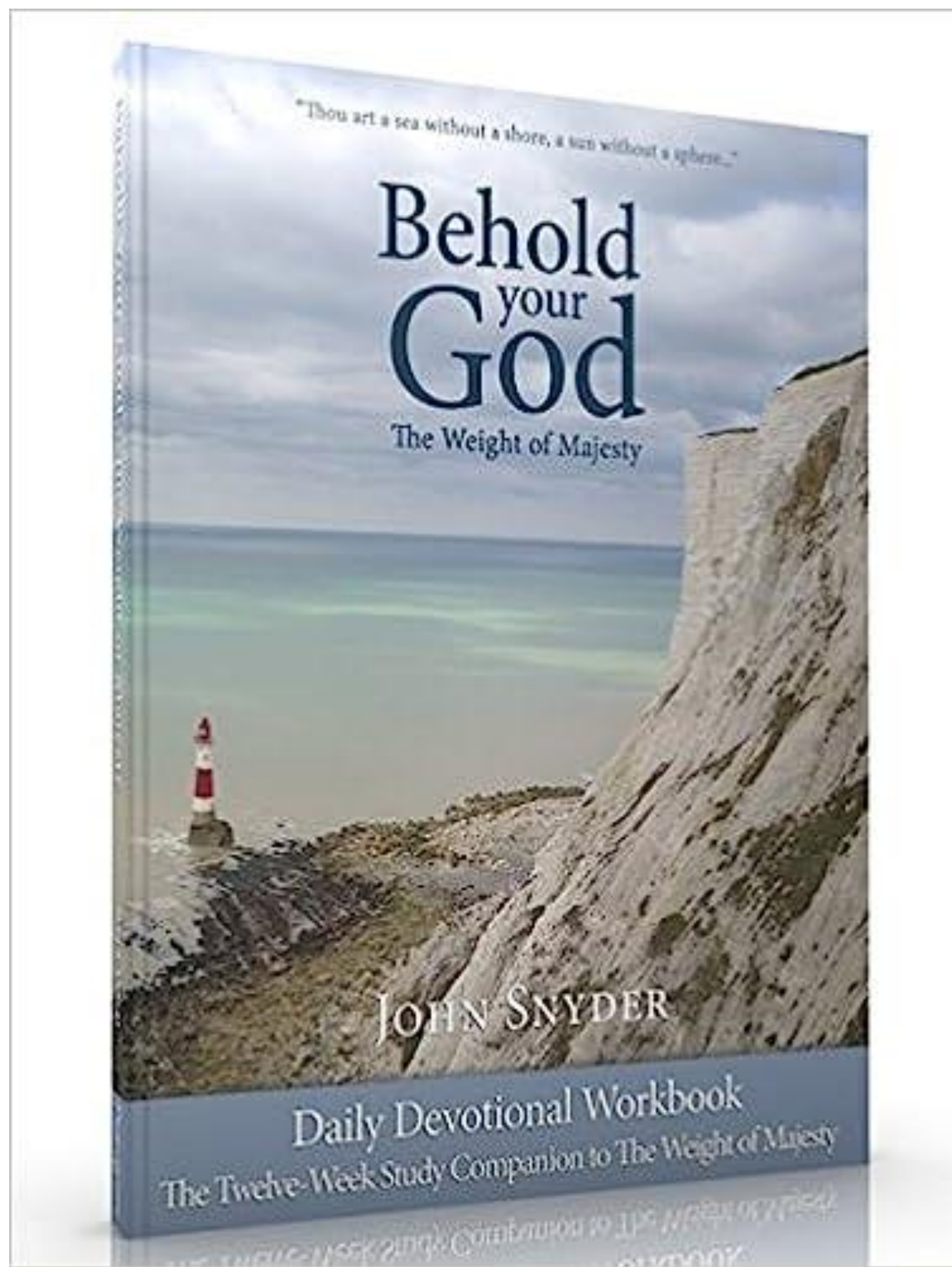
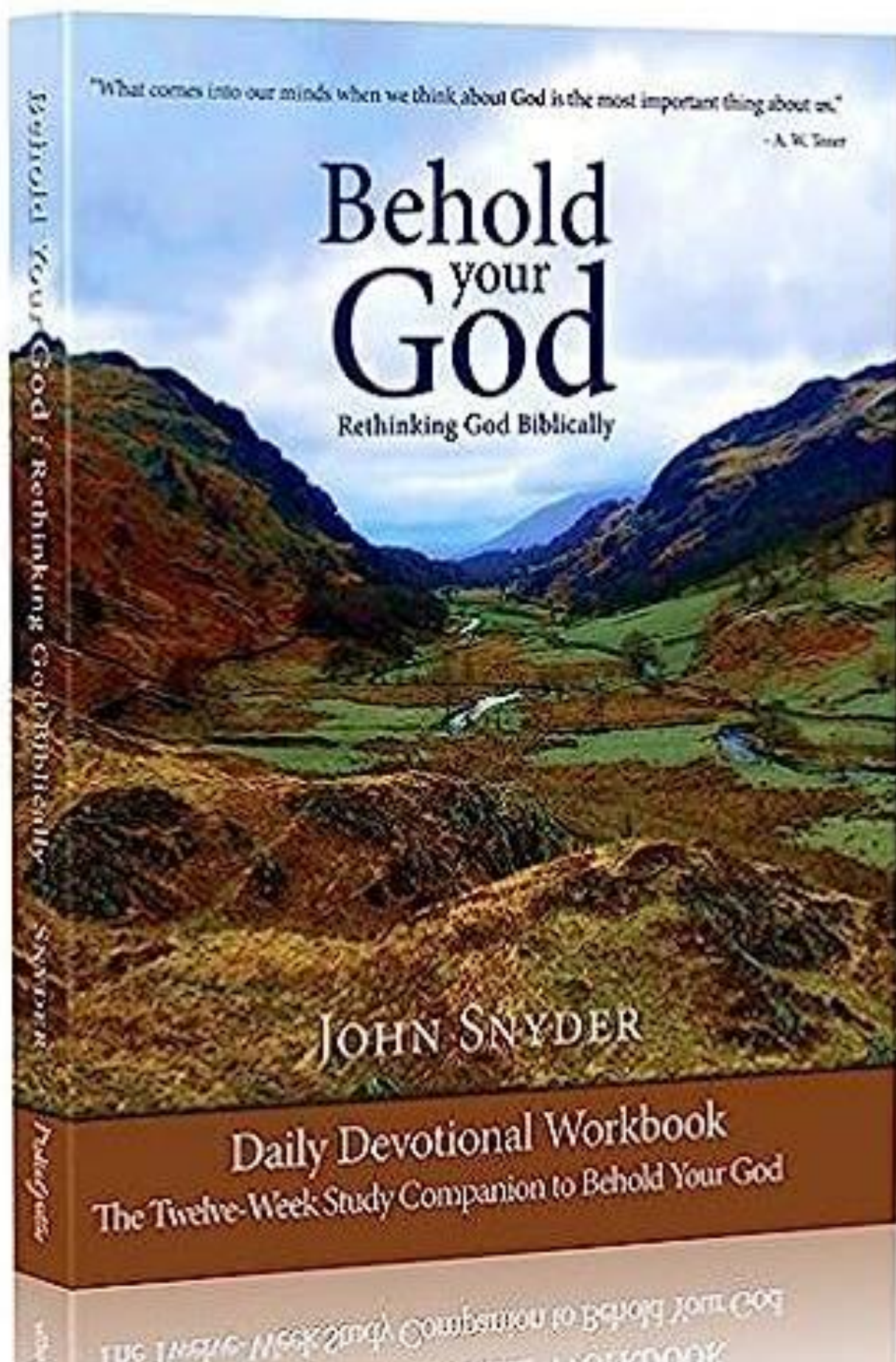
Mark 7:31-37

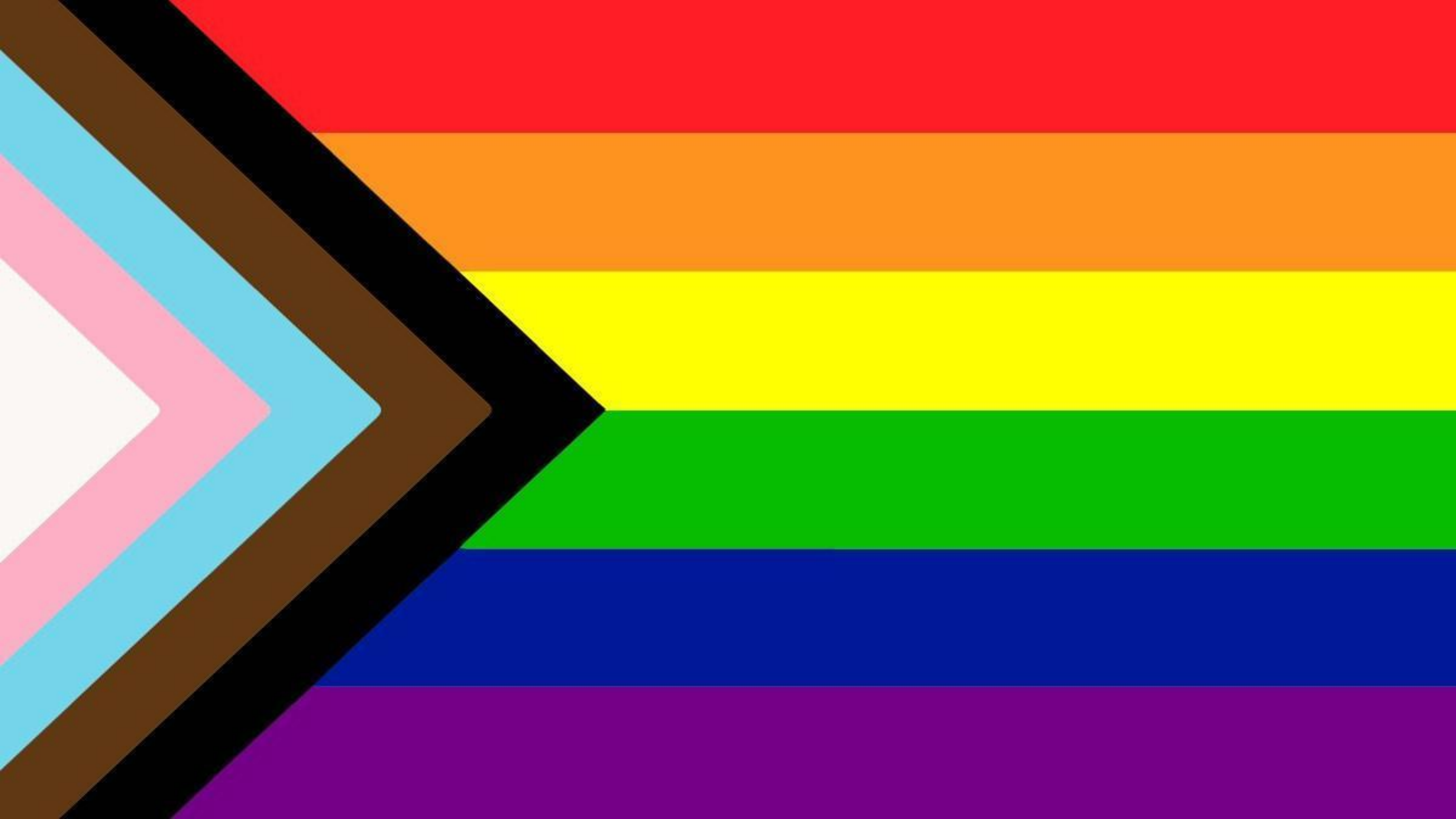
